Dear Senior Students and Parents,

On behalf of the entire faculty and staff, I take great pride in welcoming you and your student to the 2021– 2022 school year. What an exciting year as you make the final preparations for the college/career of your choice. Pioneer Parking Pass distribution will take place on Monday, August 16 from 9am – 3pm. During this time, students with a valid driver's license, who have purchased a parking pass in PowerSchool (under fees), may pick up their assigned pass. Students and parents will be able to access fees, schedules and busing information online through PowerSchool beginning August 12.

Prior to the first day of school, senior parents must complete and submit an **Emergency Medical Authorization Form** online located in PowerSchool. Parents must log in to PowerSchool and select OLSD Parent Forms. This form, along with other back-to-school forms will be available beginning August 12. Please note, parents who have not updated their PowerSchool information, will not have access to the mandatory forms and schedules.

MANDATORY FORMS TO BE COMPLETED IN POWERSCHOOL:

- ☐ **The Emergency Medical Authorization Form** – Ohio law requires that you submit a new form each school year even if no information has changed. Please also include your student's cell phone number on the Emergency Medical Form. We will then be able to send out important text messages to your student regarding a change in schedule or school closings or delays.
- ☐ **Handbook Awareness Statement** – requires both parent and student electronic signature. This is part 7 of the Emergency Medical Form.
- ☐ **Pupil Driving Permit Registration and Agreement** – This form can be found under "Lunch and Fee Payments". The fee for the parking permit is \$35. ***NOTE: All outstanding student fees must be paid, in full, in order to obtain a Pupil Driving Permit.**

Senior pictures for the yearbook and senior composite: Root Studios is the official photographer for taking the senior portraits for the yearbook. There is no charge for the picture to be taken, however, Root Studios does offer senior packages if you are interested. Any senior not photographed by Root Studios will not appear in the yearbook or on the class composite. Root Studios will be photographing seniors at Olen tangy Orange High School on “Senior Dress Up Day”, Monday, October 25. If seniors cannot get their picture taken in October, the last time to take a senior portrait for the yearbook will be on Friday, January 7, on group/club photo day.

When school resumes on Thursday, August 19, classes will begin at 7:20 a.m., and students will be dismissed at 2:35 p.m. **The school WILL NOT be printing schedules for the first day of school. Students need to print off a copy of their schedule on Wednesday, August 18 and bring it on the first day of school for them to follow.**

- **Labor Day** – No school for students or staff - Monday, September 6
