Dear Freshman Students and Parents,

On behalf of the entire faculty and staff, I take great pride in welcoming you and your student to Olentangy Orange High School (OOHS), home of the Pioneers! OOHS is an extraordinary school, with so much to offer, and we encourage all students and families to take advantage of the tremendous opportunities available to you over the next four years. As you get involved, it will be our pleasure to help you and your family transition into high school.

Let me also reassure you that most students find the transition to high school very positive and exciting. If there are any questions or concerns during this time, please ask anyone on the staff for help. We are all ready to partner with you to make your child comfortable and ready to learn.

Of most importance to your freshman is *Pioneer Orientation* on Friday, August 12. Please drop off your student at the school's main entrance by 9:00 a.m. and pick them up at 12:00 p.m. During *Pioneer Orientation*, your child will learn about the school, walk through their schedule, visit the lunch lines, meet OOHS Administrators, and generally acclimate to their new learning environment. If your child cannot attend *Pioneer Orientation*, he/she can come on August 15 between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. to walk their schedule and acclimate with a parent.

Prior to the first day of school, freshman parents must complete and submit an **Emergency Medical Authorization Form** online located in PowerSchool. Parents must log in to PowerSchool and select Back to School Forms. Students and parents will be able to access forms, schedules, locker and busing information online through PowerSchool beginning August 11. Please note, parents who have not updated their PowerSchool information, will not have access to the mandatory forms and schedules.

MANDATORY FORMS TO BE COMPLETED IN POWERSCHOOL:

- The Emergency Medical Authorization Form Ohio law requires that you submit a new form each school year even if no information has changed. Please also include your student's cell phone number on the Emergency Medical Form. We will then be able to send out important text messages to your student regarding a change in schedule or school closings or delays.
- Handbook Awareness Statement requires both parent and student electronic signature. This is section 7 of the Emergency Medical Form. Freshmen will receive a Student Handbook at Pioneer Orientation.
